Deergrass is a large, perennial bunchgrass found in canyons and woodlands below 7,000 feet. It grows up to 3 feet tall and wide, with olive green foliage and tall, slender, buff-colored flower spikes in summer that can reach 5 feet. A striking accent, this cool-season grass is heat and drought tolerant and looks nice in masses, adding an element of texture to plantings on slopes, borders and parkways. Plant it in full sun or partial shade in well drained soil and water once or twice a month for best results. Native Americans ground the seeds into a meal and used the flower stalks for weaving baskets. Plant Deergrass with Arctostaphylos, Artemisia, Ceanothus, Cercocarpus, Epilobium, Eriogonum, Opuntia, Penstemon, Salvia and Quercus.
